

Letter to year 10 Parents/Carers

Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope this letter finds you and your family safe and well.

Planning for September has been difficult due to the uncertainty around social distancing. However, we now know we can welcome our Year 10 students back to school **on Friday 4th September**. Our year 10 students are asked to come to school for 9:30 on that morning. They will then leave site at 1.20pm.

For the next week – 7th September – 11th September – year 10 students will attend on **Monday 7th September, Wednesday 9th September and Friday 11th September**. They will attend from **9:30 -1:20pm** and will then return home for lunch. They can bring a water bottle and a snack in to school with them.

When not in school, the students will still be expected to undertake some learning. We will support them with this.

Please can students wear their Pentrehafod uniform each day in school.

After this first 8 days we will then have **all year groups** in together. (Monday September 14th – more on the start and end times to follow but this will be more along the lines of a normal school day).

The A3 sheet attached provides a detailed plan for each year group for September. You can find all this information on our website under the section, '**Plans for September, 2020**'. During the summer holidays please can you keep checking the school website as there could be changes to planning. There is also a video explaining this reintroduction phase.

I have also included the interim report we produced for your son/daughter created in March. Due to Covid-19 we have been unable to complete any further assessments.
